2018 Bus & Baggage Transportation Form

Lake Greeley Camp provides bus transportation to and from camp at five convenient locations. The camp charters comfortable, air conditioned, coach buses that are equipped with a restroom. Your child's baggage is collected at the same time he or she boards the bus. The bus and baggage service is available four times during the summer on these days:

- To camp on opening day, June 24th
- From camp at end of First Half session and Session 2, July 21st
- To camp at beginning of Second Half session and Session 3, July 22nd
- From camp on the last day, August 18th

The bus and baggage service is not available for camp departures at the end of the Session 1 and Session 3 or for camp arrivals at the start of Session 2 and Session 4.

The bus stop locations are: West Nyack, NY; Manhasset, NY; Kenilworth, NJ; Plymouth Meeting, PA; and White Marsh, MD. The fee for this optional service is \$150.00 roundtrip or \$80.00 one way, except for the White Marsh bus location, which is \$170.00 roundtrip or \$90.00 one way. **If the bus and baggage service is cancelled within one week of the date of travel, the associated transportation fee will be charged even though the bus and baggage service is not used.**

The bus ride to camp will take approximately three to five hours depending upon your child's departure location. We anticipate the buses to arrive at camp between 11:30 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. Campers traveling to camp by bus should bring a snack or lunch on board for the trip. Upon arriving at camp, campers will be served lunch regardless of the time they arrive. Campers are limited to one standard sized trunk (hard or soft), a duffel bag (or similar item), and a sleeping bag. The luggage is transported on the bus or on a baggage truck which follows the bus to camp. Your child's luggage will be picked up/dropped off at the same location and time as your child's scheduled bus departure/arrival.

You'll receive a bus and baggage schedule about five days prior to your child's arrival/departure. The schedule will include your bus stop location, driving directions to the bus stop location, and the time of pick up/drop off. Campers, who are traveling to camp by bus, will receive, along with a bus schedule, baggage tags to attach to your child's luggage. All bags (including small carry on bags) need to be tagged. All tags need to be labeled with your child's name.
